Proof of sufficient basic knowledge of the German language <i>A 1 language Certificate</i> <u>Proof not required by:</u> - applicants whose spouse is an acknowledged asylum seeker or refugees according to the Geneva Convention for Refugees if the marriage already existed at the time when he or she established their main ordinary residence outside Pakistan - applicants whose spouse is a Blue Card holder - applicants who apply for family reunion with their spouse who is a citizen of a EU member state other than Germany - applicants who apply for family reunion with their German child	- Proof of your language abilities according to the standards of the Association of Language Testers in Europe (ALTE). - In Pakistan, such exams can only be taken at the Goethe-Institut (GI). However, you are free to decide how and where to prepare for these exams. - The A1 language certificate by the Goethe-Institute is sufficient. - Where to learn German in Pakistan?
For applicants at the Embassy only: Please provide a copy of the appointment confirmation e-mail	- Including the provided booking code (e.g. "isla_588207")
If applicable: (Travel) health insurance for 90 days	- The insurance will be requested upon visa issuance
Visa fees	- 75 Euro (adults) - 37,50 Euro (between 0 and 17 years) - If you intend to join a German or EU national, no visa fee will be charged

In order to apply for a visa to get married in Germany and subsequent permanent settlement you have to submit all the documents mentioned above (including the A1 language certificate). Instead of the marriage certificate the following documents have to be handed in:

- Confirmation by the German marriage office (Standesamt) concerning the wedding date,
- Affidavit of support / formal obligation (please refer to the competent Aliens Authority).
