

Visa application preparation and checklist

Recognition Measure for a Foreign Qualification

Section 16d Residence Act

When applying, you must present **all documents** mentioned on the checklist. Please make sure to present **originals** and prepare all documents as described in the following. In addition, you must present **one complete set of copies**.

How to prepare your documents

<u>To 1):</u> The application form must be duly **completed and signed by you**. The form can be found <u>HERE</u>. Your biometric passport photo must not be older than **six months.** It must be **glued (not stapled)** on the application form's first page in the top right-hand corner.

<u>To 2):</u> Your passport must be in duly condition and contain your **signature**. It must have at least **two empty pages** for the visa sticker and a **validity of at least one year**.

<u>To 4):</u> The application declarations must be duly **read and signed by you**. The declarations can be found HERE.

<u>To 8):</u> You must provide an Assessment Note ("Defizitbescheid", "Zwischenbescheid") granted by the competent German authority. Further information can be found <u>HERE</u>.

<u>To 9):</u> Your foreign university degree or vocational qualification diploma on which basis you have been granted your Assessment Note must be **attested by the Higher Education Commission of Pakistan (HEC).** Further information can be found <u>HERE</u>.

<u>To 10):</u> You have to provide proof of a suitable qualification program which is in accordance with your Assessment Note:

- For school-based qualification programs you must provide a registration confirmation.
- For company-based qualification programs you must provide the Employer's Declaration form ("Erklärung zum Beschäftigungsverhältnis") and the Additional form A ("Zusatzblatt A").
 Both forms must be duly completed and signed by your employer. The forms can be found HERE (Employer's Declaration form) and HERE (Additional form A).

<u>To 11):</u> In order to proof sufficient German language proficiency level A2, you must provide a **language certificate** by one of the following providers or their cooperation partners: Goethe-Institut e.V., telc GmbH, Österreichisches Sprachdiplom (ÖSD), TestDaF-Institut e.V, ECL Examination System. Your language certificate must not be older than **one year**.
